MINUTES

Attendance: 51 as per attendance register

1. Welcome by Chairman: Ken Wilson welcomed all present and thanked them for attending.

2. Apologies:

Phil & Jenni Burke, Kim Cutting, Kery Floyd, David & Helen Henderson, Barbara Higgins, Shirley Higman, George & Grace Kidgell, Julie Suggate, Judy Thompson, Elma Raverty, Brian & Lynn Wills.

Moved by Tony Murphy Seconded by Leonie Mitchell apologies to be accepted, all in favor carried.

3. Sick List & Welfare Report: Geoff Suggate:

Geoff Suggate advised he had sent a sympathy card to the Gretgrix family on the loss of Glenda.

He also said that Brian Wills was very unwell. Brian had a "turn" and had been taken by ambulance to St Vincents. Geoff had spoken with Brian who said that the doctors were not sure what exactly was the problem, but he didn't sound very good. Asked that we keep Brian and Lynn in our thoughts and prayers.

Geoff has also sent a card to Laurie Jackel who had an operation. The Club does not have a contact number for Laurie, so he was unable to call him.

4. Visitors: None

5. Minutes of the previous Meeting: The Minutes of the previous meeting 2 July 2024 having been already circulated, it was moved by Laurie Quinn and Seconded by Val Cosway that the minutes be accepted. All in favor nil against, carried.

.Business arising from previous Minutes:

- Financial Tax Return arrangements Dina Galea advised that our Club is Taxable Not For Profit and we need to complete a tax return. This does not necessarily mean we will have to pay tax as Member Subscriptions are exempt so our only income is from Bunnings Barbecues and Bank interest. We will also be able to deduct all the Club expenses and running costs from those amounts (insurance, electricity, etc.), so it is unlikely that we will have to pay tax. However, we will still need to complete a tax return, and this may need to be done by a Tax Accounting Firm. This does not need to be done until 31 May 2025. Dina will study the matter further with Brent Stephens.
- Discontinue AOMC and Federation Reps. Committee received an email from Rob Mitchell requesting review of allowances paid to AOMC and Federation reps (currently \$150.00) suggesting that an allowance of 0.72 cents per kilometre and payment for overnight accommodation where appropriate. The Committee made the decision to discontinue the practice of sending reps to these meetings due to the expense which could, at times, amount to over \$600.00 depending on the location of the meeting (AOMC meet 3 times per year in Springvale and once in regional Victoria. Federation at various regional locations 4 times per year.)

Rodney Cole said he believed that the Committee was heavy handed in "sacking" the delegates and it should be voted on by the members.

The purpose of bringing this to the members was for their acceptance or revocation of the Committee's decision.

There was various discussion and finally a motion was put as follows:

Motion: That the Club pay AOMC and Federation delegates reasonable costs for fuel and accommodation upon presentation of receipts using Club and Charity funds. Moved by Tony Galea. Seconded by Andrew Spackman. Carried by majority. 6 against.

7. Treasurer's Report:

- Dina Galea presented the Club's financial position for the month of July. Ken asked the meeting if there were any questions regarding the club's finances, but there were none. It was moved by Dina and seconded by Tony Galea that the report be accepted. All in favor nil against, carried.
- Dina also advised she had an email from AOMC regarding the proposed Group Insurance Scheme. This will take some time to get organized. AOMC is preparing a Club Handbook, with procedures and guidelines. There is no launch date as yet. It is hoped that that premium will be approximately \$400 rather than the thousands of dollars the Club currently pays.

There was a new member application from **Stephen Gale** (who was unfortunately absent due to a family issue). Susan Coad advised that she had brought him along to a coffee morning and he was very keen to join the Club. He has two vehicles: a BMW and an old Ute. 
